In the summer, these blue waters beckon fishermen and water sport enthusiasts. The tall pines and sandy beaches offer the perfect place to enjoy with family and friends. Many of our lakes are connected by rivers and channels that offer miles of uninterrupted paddling via kayak, canoe, or paddleboard.

Nestled in the heart of Minnesota's lake country, we have resorts and campgrounds on eleven area lakes that offer some of the best fishing in the state. In addition to the much-sought-after walleye, anglers find muskies, northern pike, large and smallmouth bass, crappies, sunfish, and other panfish in our waters. Make sure to check specific lakes for fishing regulations. Licenses can be purchased at Full Stringer Bait & Tackle and The One Stop.

The fun doesn't stop when the lakes freeze over! The Longville Lakes area offers great ice fishing.

Into the Wild:

Exploring the Enchanted Woods of Our Area

Water isn't all we have — our forests are nearly as famous as our lakes. We embrace a portion of the beautiful Chippewa National Forest and offer more than 100 miles of paved trails for bikers and inline skaters. We also have specially designated routes for ATVs and OHVs.

In the winter, these routes accommodate snowmobiles, cross-country skiers, and snowshoers.

Longville offers a direct connection to the Paul Bunyan State Trail via designated bike routes along County Roads 5 and 11. The Paul Bunyan Trail is the longest bike trail in Minnesota, running 112 miles from Brainerd to Bemidji. It also connects with the Heartland, Blue Ox, and Cuyuna State Recreation Area Trails, offering endless opportunities to explore the wild.

in the beautiful Chippewa National Forest, a section of the North Country Trail tracks right through the Longville area. As America's longest National Scenic Trail, it offers hikers a unique opportunity to explore nature at its best. The Longville area is the perfect place to look for bird species, wildflowers, or just take in nature's serenity with a quiet walk in the woods.

Hunting and trapping are also popular, and our varied wildlife habitats offer the perfect opportunity to take full advantage of all the seasons. With all the lakes, plus state and national forests nearby, you're never far from a place to hunt or trap. Popular wildlife includes deer, bear, grouse, ducks, geese, turkeys, rabbits, timberwolves, and foxes.


Area Activities Throughout the Year
